Dr. Beth Borosh is a licensed clinical psychologist, specialized in neuropsychological assessment, intervention, and consultation. She completed her Bachelor of Science in Psychology at John Carroll University and obtained her Doctorate in Clinical Psychology from Nova Southeastern University (NSU). She completed one year of internship training in Clinical Neuropsychology at Emory University Center for Rehabilitation Medicine and two years of fellowship training in Clinical Neuropsychology at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine and the Cognitive Neurology Alzheimer's Disease Center.

Dr. Borosh is currently licensed in Illinois and holds an academic appointment as Assistant Professor at Northwestern University, Department of Psychiatry and the Cognitive Neurology and Alzheimer's Disease Center. She is a professional member of the American Psychological Association (APA), Illinois Psychological Association (IPA), National Academy of Neuropsychology (NAN), and the International Neuropsychological Society (INS).

Dr. Borosh specializes in neuropsychological evaluation of adults (over the age of 20) who present with a wide variety of psychiatric and neurobehavioral syndromes. Her special interests include age-related cognitive decline and brain health.

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The goals of the neuropsychological assessment are: diagnosis, description of cognitive and behavioral deficits and strengths, and generation of recommendations that may include suggestions for further evaluation, referrals to community agencies, and/or suggestions for specific brain wellness strategies found beneficial to optimize memory, thinking, and quality of life.

Dr. Borosh provides brief preliminary feedback about the results of the assessment at the time of the visit. A confidential report is sent to the patient and health care professional who made the referral. Release of the report to others can only be accomplished by the patient's signed request. Dr. Borosh also educates families and caregivers to aid in understanding disease related issues.
